

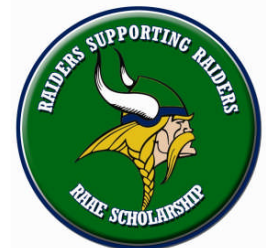

 - A way to ensure that friends stay in touch



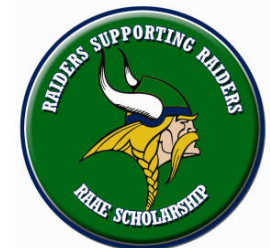
Current Program: R.A.A.E. Scholarship

- “Raider Alumni Athletic Excellence Scholarship”
- Objectives
 - To honour those who have shown excellence in athletics, as well as proven commitment to academics and an overall drive to make the school a better place.
 - To foster the tradition of all-around excellence displayed by current Erindale S.S. student athletes.
 - Expand scholarship by encouraging participation from all former Erindale athletes



R.A.A.E. Scholarship

- Eligibility
 - Any graduating student from Erindale S.S.
 - Must have attended Erindale S.S. for a minimum of two years.
 - Must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student at either a college or university in the fall semester after his or her graduation. (Exceptions can be made on a case-by-case basis)

- Build legacy and support importance of “giving back”

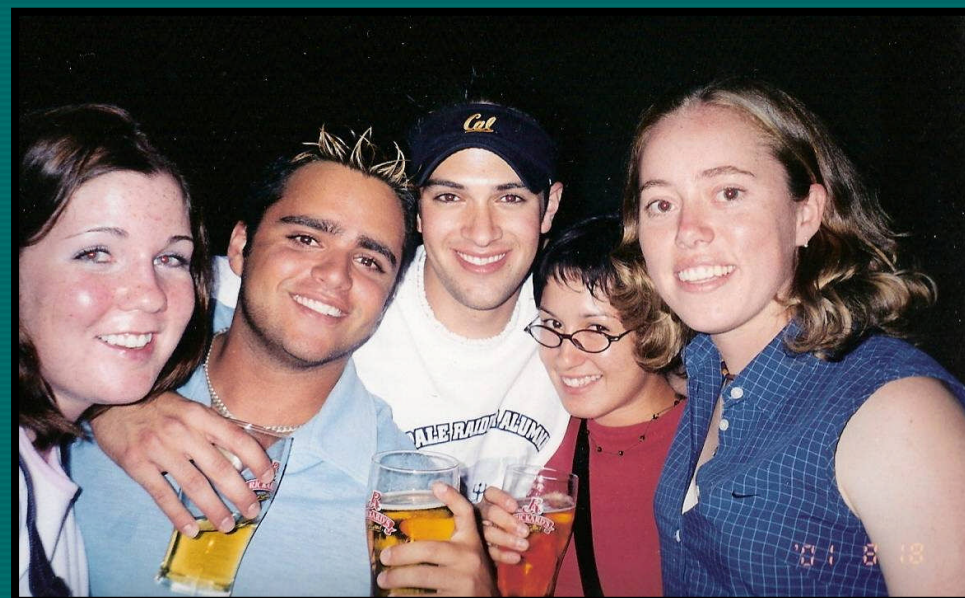


Help Build the R.A.A.E. Scholarship

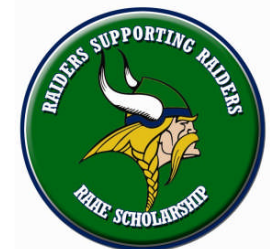

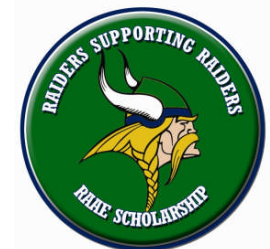
History: 1998-2003

 - Web's, Subway, Rampant & Rose, Fujitsu, Century Graphic Supply Inc.

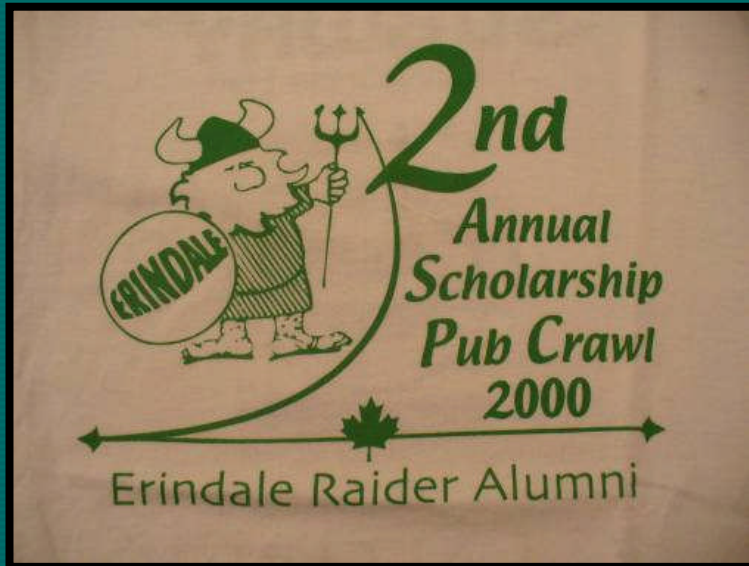


History: 2003-2006

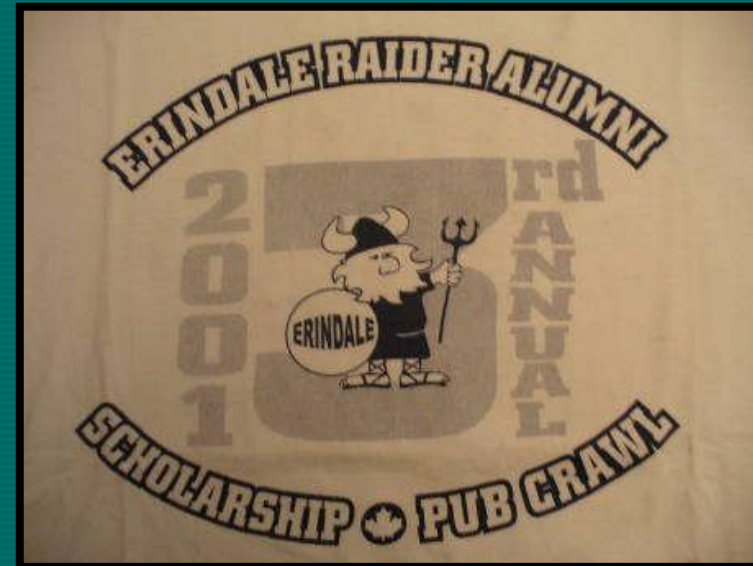
- Geographic limitations result in re-structuring of program

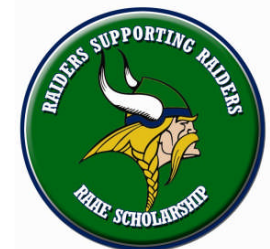

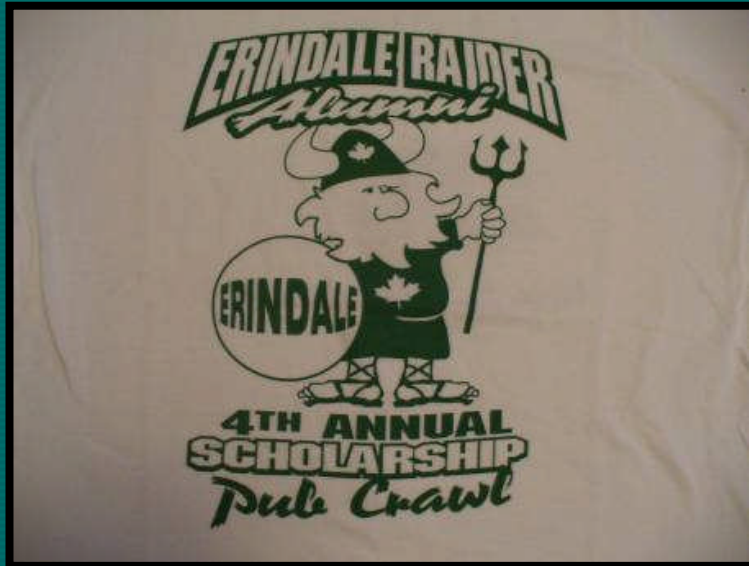
2000: The 2nd Annual



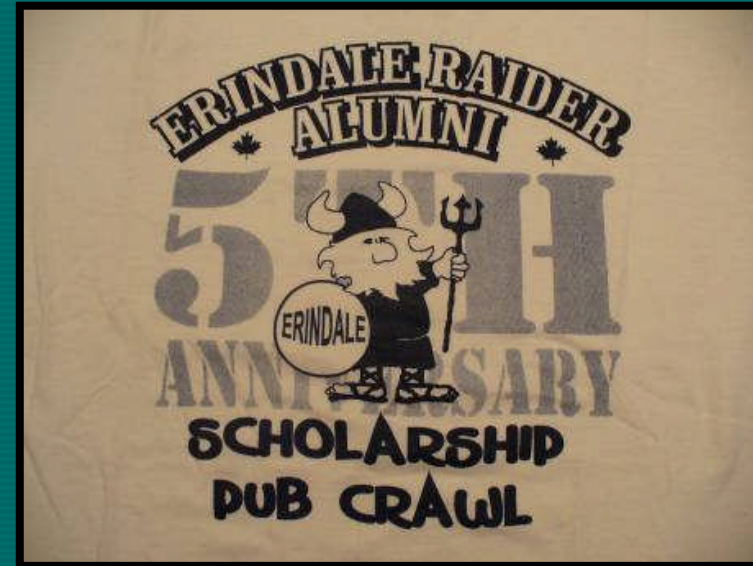
2001: The 3rd Annual



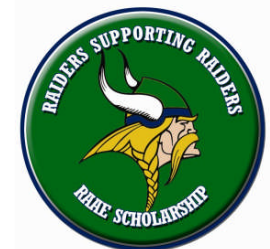
The Scholarship Pub Crawl



2002: The 4th Annual

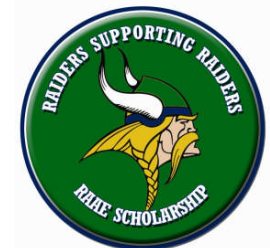

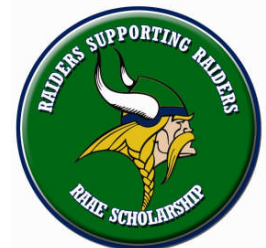
